**NEW BUSINESS:**

Officer Bill Hipple advised that one ongoing issue has been referred to a city committee. He reiterated that information relative to open issues cannot be made known to Board members so as to not influence any future decisions.

Officer Hipple advised his <sup>ONE MONTH</sup> ~~year-to-date~~ activity amounts to 523 issues, including 341 area checks and 84 situations pertaining to city business. His schedule includes drive-thru in all areas of the city. A current example of his work:

A boat is improperly parked and should be moved. Officer leaves a warning notes which goes unheeded. A warning citation is issued. While this issue is open, Officer Hipple keeps records and works toward compliance.

A discussion was held relative to backyard sheds that are unkempt and surrounded by junk. Officer Hipple will address this issue further. Often, these violations cannot be seen from the front and may go undetected.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.


