City Clerk: This week, the City received a \$3,000 grant from KLC for the Safety Grant.

Kelly has done a very good job and he thanked council for allowing him to create this position. They are helping a lot of people and resolving issues before having to file charges and going to court.

Public Works Committee: Bob Simon – They met tonight to review the report from Precision Concrete in which they assessed every sidewalk in the city to see what needs to be done to make them ADA compliant. The total cost for everything in the report is \$161,465. There is money for some sidewalk repair this year, and they will decide what needs to be done first and how to approach the project within the next five years.

Sam Trapp reported the salt is in the barn and he is ready for any bad weather.

Mr. Duncan then read the Oath of Office and swore in all of the re-elected council members for 2017-2018.


ADJOURNMENT:
