ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Metal Cans (aluminum, steel, empty aerosol cans with lids & tips removed)
- Plastic Bottles and Jugs (bottles that have a small mouth and wider base, such as milk jugs, soda bottles, or laundry detergent)
- Paper (newspaper, magazines, cardboard, envelopes, cardboard)
- Cartons (milk, juice, soup, broth, etc.)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Plastic Bags,
- Batteries
- Plastic that is NOT a bottle or jug (butter tubs, other food packaging)
- Cassette Tapes
- Hangers
- Metal Chains
- Garden Hoses
- Needles, Syringes
- Electronics & Car Parts,
- Food
- Foam
- Yard Waste
- Light Bulbs
- Drinking Glasses
- Ceramics
- Pots/Pans
- Scrap Metal
