## ORDINANCE 2019 - 01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 31.44 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO MODIFY THE COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** Section 31.44 of the City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§ 31.44 MEMBERS OF CITY PLANNING COMMISSION.

(A) The city hereby establishes the office of Member of City Planning Commission. The position of Member of City Planning Commission shall hereinafter be classified as a nonelected office.

(B) There shall be seven members of the Planning Commission whose terms of office, appointments, powers and duties of office shall be governed by KRS Ch. 100.

(C) Each member of the Planning Commission shall be required to execute the oath of office as set forth in Section 228 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky prior to the assumption of the duties of that office.

(D) There are no bond requirements for this office unless specifically established by the Planning Commission by-laws for those officers of the Planning Commission who handle public funds.

(E) Compensation for each citizen member of the Planning Commission shall be **[twenty] forty dollars (\$[20] 40.00) per meeting, and forty eighty dollars (\$[40] 80.00) per meeting** for the Chairperson with a maximum of two (2) meetings per month.

**SECTION 2:** All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such, conflict hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

**SECTION 4:** This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and approval according to law, and publication thereafter.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.

**SECTION 6:** The foregoing Ordinance was introduced by Council Member Stacey Graus, was read, passed and adopted by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Kentucky, meeting in **regular sessions on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019, and on the 16 day of May, 2019, with 5 yes votes, 0 no votes, and 0 abstentions**, and was thereafter approved by the Mayor and ordered published in summary according to law.
