EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-06

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA SUSPENDING THE ISSUANCE OF PEDDLERS/SOLICITORS/ITINERANT MERCHANT LICENSES UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing spread of the COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus, it has been determined to be in the best interests of the citizens of Alexandria, Kentucky, to suspend any and all door-to-door sales in the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, as such, until further notice there will be no licenses issued to peddlers, solicitors, or itinerant merchants for the purpose of door-to-door sales; and any current licenses for these types of sales that have already been issued are hereby suspended until further notice.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Until further notice, there shall be no new licenses issued for the purpose of door-to-door sales by peddlers, solicitors, or itinerant merchants.

SECTION 2: Until further notice, all current licenses for door-to-door sales by peddlers, solicitors, or itinerant merchants are hereby suspended.

SECTION 3: This order shall be effective upon its execution and shall remain binding until same is revoked or otherwise terminated.
