EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-08

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA
RESCINDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER #2020-03.**

THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, upon recommendations by Governor Andy Beshear's office, Mayor Andy Schabell signed Executive Order 2020-03 on March 18, 2020, in an attempt to slow the spread of the COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus, by suspending and/or cancelling all meetings and events, including but not limited to recreational events, and

WHEREAS, Governor Beshear has issued new guidelines relaxing some of the restrictions that had been put in place and a schedule to begin reopening the commonwealth's economy, allowing groups of up to fifty (50) people to begin gathering after June 29, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. SECTION 1 of Executive Order 2020-03 suspending all private events/rentals at city facilities is now hereby rescinded.
2. SECTION 2 of Executive Order 2020-03 suspending and/or cancelling all bi-monthly City Council and Planning & Zoning meetings, and all other scheduled meetings until further notice is now hereby rescinded.
3. All other sections of Executive Order 2020-03 shall remain in place until further notice.
