



ORDINANCE 2020 - 09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING CHAPTER 74, SCHEDULE III OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO SET THE SPEED LIMIT ON POPLAR RIDGE ROAD AT TWENTY-FIVE (25 M.P.H.) MILES PER HOUR.

WHEREAS, the City has determined that there is a need to lower the speed limit on Poplar Ridge Road in the City from Thirty (30 m.p.h.) to Twenty-Five (25 m.p.h.) miles per hour in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and visitors of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 189.390 and Section 71.05 of the Alexandria Code of Ordinances, and based upon the City's investigations and experience, the City has determined that the safe speed for vehicles traveling Poplar Ridge Road in the City is Twenty-Five (25 m.p.h.) miles per hour.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 74, Schedule III of the City of Alexandria Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

SCHEDULE III. SPEED LIMITS.

(A) Speed limits are hereby established for the following streets:

(B) Penalty. The penalty for violation of any speed limit in the city shall be in accordance with the fine schedule set forth in KRS 189.394.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such, conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and approval according to law, and publication thereafter.

SECTION 5: This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.


