EXECUTIVE ORDER 2023-03

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
ALEXANDRIA RESCINDING EXECUTIVE ORDER #2020-02.**

THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, upon recommendations by State and Federal Officials, Mayor Andy Schabell signed Executive Order 2020-02 on March 18, 2020, in an attempt to slow the spread of the COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus, by declaring a state of emergency for the City of Alexandria, and,

WHEREAS, such authority was leveled to apply for funding and regulate programs to help mitigate the effects of COVID-19 on the city's residents and businesses; and,

WHEREAS, The Federal declaration of emergency was rescinded on May 11, 2023 ending the national emergency related to the COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS, that Executive Order 2020-02 is hereby rescinded, effective May 11, 2023
